**Geraldine Cardiel** was born and raised in Mexico City. She holds a Certificate in Modern Dance from The Americas University in Mexico. Ms. Cardiel's choreography has been produced in New York by Skirball Center for the Performing Arts, Joyce SoHo Presents, DanceNow Festival, The Local Produce Festival, Joyce SoHo, and Dance New Amsterdam. She has also participated in the Celebrate Mexico Now festivals in New York City in 2004-2007. She has received international awards in Mexico City's XXIV Premio INBA/UAM Contemporary Choreography Competition (2003) and the Masdanza International Choreography Festival in the Canary Islands (2005). She is currently on faculty at the Limón Institute and Long Island University-Brooklyn, and is a guest teacher at international festivals.

**Michael Blake** holds an MFA in dance from Purchase College. He began his dance career in the Murray Louis Dance Company where he danced from 1982-1984. In 1986 he joined the Jose Limon Dance Company, dancing principal roles until 1991. Michael danced with Donald Byrd/The Group from 1991-1998. He has also danced with the Joyce Trisler Danscompany, Shapiro and Smith, and Janis Brenner and Friends. He has taught numerous workshops both nationally and internationally, and is on the theater arts faculty at Rutgers University, and HB Studio, NYC, teaching Movement for Actors. Michael currently dances with PARADIGM Dance.

**Alan Danielson** (School Director) has been teaching and directing classes and workshops at the Limón Institute since 1991. His company, Dance by Alan Danielson, has performed throughout the US, Mexico and Europe, and his choreography has been performed by many professional and student companies. He is a frequent guest artist for dance festivals, companies and conservatories around the world, and has been on faculty at NYU Tisch School of the Arts and the Alvin Ailey American Dance Center. He also teaches Music for Dancers, Accompaniment for Musicians, Choreography, and Teaching Methodology.

**Ann Vachon**, Director of the Limón Institute, was a member of the dance faculty at Temple University for over 25 years. A graduate of the Juilliard School, she performed with the Limón Company from 1958 to 66 and 1971 to 75. In 1981, she founded Dance Conduit, a Philadelphia-based company that presented original choreography and historic reconstructions of Limón and Humphrey works. She is the producer of the award winning documentary film, Limón: A Life Beyond Words.
