### **LIMÓN TEACHERS WORKSHOP** JULY 6 – 15

This nine day workshop welcomes participants who are currently teaching Limón-based classes, or are interested in doing so. The program includes daily technique classes, an exploration of underlying principles of Limón technique, Limón and Humphrey repertory phrases, rhythm and music in Limón classes, designing a Limón technique class, developing early class work and creating contemporary dance phrases for Limón-based classes.

Participants should be currently teaching, or be a recent graduate of a teaching program. The workshop meets from 10 am to 4:30 pm every day except Sunday, with special evening activities. The faculty includes **Alan Danielson**, **Roxane D'Orleans Juste** and **Ann Vachon**.
